And with Kyle (17 pts, 8 rebs), Zane (16 pts, 9 rebs), and Cavell (10 pts) scoring for the A's, Brampton took a 119-116 victory over the London Lightning to remain only a half-game out of second place in the NBL's Central Division.</p>

Starting out on Wednesday night against the Windsor Express, the Rainmen were decimated 95-68, with only Kevin Young's 28-point, nine-rebound night as one of the team's few highlights. Pedro Foster added 14 points, while Tyrone Watson put up nine.</p> <p>Although the Rainmen did improve their scoring on Thursday night, they coughed up another loss, this time 114-85 to the Mississauga Power. Tyrone Watson and Kevin Young scored 24 and 22 points, respectively; Young also had 8 assists on the night.</p> <p>Returning to the Scotiabank Centre on Sunday afternoon, the Rainmen took out their frustration on the Saint John Mill Rats, and claimed a much-needed 119-115 victory. All five starters for Halifax scored in double figures; including 22 points and 14 rebounds from Kevin Young; 21 points from Forrest Fisher (including going 5-for-9 from three-point range), 16 points from both Liam McMorrow and Christopher Cayole; and 15 points from Seyia Ando.</p>

But even with 24 points from Brandon Robinson, and a 22-point, 12-rebound double-double from Nick Evans, the Storm were drained 120-111 by the Miracles. Sammy Zeglinski led with 11 assists; while Louis Birdsong, Jr. blocked four shots.</p>

Brent Jennings came off the bench to score 18 points; while John Hart and Ed Horton contributed 11 points apiece.</p>

Then came an eleven-game losing streak that threatened to give the Power its fourth consecutive regular season losing streak. But with the efforts of Warren Ward, who finished the night with 28 points and 11 rebounds, the Power finally cracked back into the winning column with a 114-85 victory over the Halifax Rainmen. Tyrone Garland added 26 points, while Travis Releford was one rebound shy of the NBL's first triple-double of the season (16 points, 10 assists, 9 rebounds).</p> <p>Unfortunately for the Power, they next ran into the Windsor Express on Saturday evening, and dropped a 106-96 loss at the Hershey Centre. The loss came despite 24 points from Warren Ward, and a 19-point, 11-rebound night from Travis Releford. Ward actually led the Power in four statistical categories; he was also the high man for assists (4), blocked shots (1) and steals (3).</p>

And in a hard-fought battle with Saint John on Thursday night, the Miracles fell 116-111, despite Stanley Robinson's 25 points and 10 rebounds, as well as Dwayne Smith's 18 points and 12 boards. Daquan Brooks added 7 team-high assists to go with his 11 points.</p> <p>Moncton's next match with Saint John, this time at Harbour Station, was not as close. In fact, the Miracles fell 147-99, even with 22 points from Tamar Sutherland, 14 points from Daquan Brooks, and a 13-rebound night from Trayvon Lathan.</p> <p>However, after that 48-point loss, the Miracles rebounded and dealt the division-leading Island Storm a loss, winning 120-111. Trayvon Lathan and Shawn VanZant pounded 24 points apiece in the victory; Troy Brewer added 23. Lathan also led with 11 rebounds, while Dwayne Smith pulled down 10 boards in the Miracles win.</p>

Johnny Mayhane led the Rats in scoring with 31 points; while Kenny Jones and Darin Mency hit 23 points apiece. Mency also had 11 rebounds for the Mill Rats.</p> <p>The rematch on Saturday night at Harbour Station wasn't as close. In fact, the Mill Rats set a franchise record with a 147-99 trouncing of Moncton in front of over 2,200 fans. Once again, Johnny Mayhane was the top scorer for Saint John with 25 points; Rahiem Singleton and Kenny Jones achieved 18 points apiece, while Alex "Superman" Johnson had 13 points and 15 assists.</p> <p>The five-game winning streak came to an end on Sunday afternoon, as the Mill Rats dropped a 119-115 road loss to the Halifax Rainmen. NBL CANADA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

The National Basketball League of Canada is pleased to announce that Warren Ward of the Mississauga Power has been named Player of the Week for the week ending January 25, 2015. This is the first time that a player from the Mississauga Power has received this honour.

The National Basketball League of Canada has confirmed the following playoff format for the 2014-15 NBL season. The magic number listed will count down to clinching the regular season division lead. When the magic number reaches zero, the team in first place has mathematically clinched the division title.

In the NBL quarterfinals, teams #1-#4 and teams #2-#3 will play each other in a best-of-five series, with a 2-2-1 format. The higher seed will have home court for games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 5.

In the NBL semifinals, the divisional teams will face each other in a best-of-seven series,

with a 2-2-1-1-1 format. The higher seed will host games 1, 2, and (if necessary) 5 and 7.

The remaining team in each division will play each other in the NBL Finals, which will be a best-of-seven series with a 2-3-2 format. The team with the higher regular season winning percentage will receive home court advantage for Games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 6 and 7. The winner of that series will be named National Basketball League of Canada Playoff Champion and receive a championship trophy commemorating their victory.

In the event that two or more teams are tied in terms of playoff seeding, the following tiebreakers will take place, in order of importance:

- (1) head-to-head record shall determine the winner;
- (2) if still a tie, head-to-head record against common opponents will determine the winner;
- (3) if still a tie, points scored in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (4) if still a tie, average margin of victory in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (5) if still a tie, the team correctly calling the flip of a coin will be seeded higher.

Playoff format subject to change due to venue availability.
