The Windsor Express are inching closer and closer to the #1 seed in the NBL's Central Division, and with that, home-court advantage in the first two rounds of the playoffs. The Express started their conquest on Wednesday night with the first of two victories over the London Lightning, 114-100, with Quinnel Brown launching a team-high 22 points. Ryan Anderson achieved a nice double-double of 20 points and 11 rebounds; while Tony Bennett distributed 12 assists with a double-double of 11 points.

The Express continued their winning streak in the second of the home-and-away series, 111-93 over London. Quinnel Brown was again the leading scorer for Windsor, with 30 points and 6 rebounds. Tony Bennett and Ryan Anderson added 20 and 14 points, respectively; while Kevin Loiselle's 7 rebounds led the team in that category.

But the Express' six-game winning streak came to an abrupt end on Sunday afternoon, as the NBL champions lost a blowout to the Halifax Rainmen 124-99. Quinnel Brown and Ryan Anderson were the top scorers that afternoon for Windsor, as they put up 17 and 16 points. Jamarcus Ellis (14) and Tony Bennett (13) also scored in double figures for Windsor.

Windsor holds tiebreaker over The Island (point differential)

The National Basketball League of Canada has confirmed the following playoff format for the 2014-15 NBL season. The magic number listed will count down to clinching the regular season division lead. When the magic number reaches zero, the team in first place has mathematically clinched the division title.

In the NBL quarterfinals, teams #1-#4 and teams #2-#3 will play each other in a best-of-five series, with a 2-2-1 format. The higher seed will have home court for games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 5.

In the NBL semifinals, the divisional teams will face each other in a best-of-seven series, with a 2-2-1-1-1 format. The

higher seed will host games 1, 2, and (if necessary) 5 and 7.

The remaining team in each division will play each other in the NBL Finals, which will be a best-of-seven series with a 2-3-2 format. The team with the higher regular season winning percentage will receive home court advantage for Games 1, 2 and (if necessary) 6 and 7. The winner of that series will be named National Basketball League of Canada Playoff Champion and receive a championship trophy commemorating their victory.

In the event that two or more teams are tied in terms of playoff seeding, the following tiebreakers will take place, in order of importance:

- (1) head-to-head record shall determine the winner;
- (2) if still a tie, head-to-head record against common opponents will determine the winner;
- (3) if still a tie, points scored in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (4) if still a tie, average margin of victory in head to head competition will determine the winner;
- (5) if still a tie, the team correctly calling the flip of a coin will be seeded higher.

Playoff format subject to change due to venue availability.
